

CWGA 18 Annual Tournament and Other Awards

CWGA 18 Club Championship – Costs for engraving names on Trophies, Plaques and the purchase of gifts and flowers are covered specifically in the current year's CWGA 18 Budget under Trophies and Gifts. For the Champion, the gift is usually a commemorative crystal item engraved with Caloosa logo, year and name of tournament. The low gross flight winners receive a smaller gift. The Handicap Chairlady chooses and purchases the gifts. She needs to know the number of flights in the tournament for that year.

Prize money (chits) awarded to the overall Club Champion and the Low Gross winners in each flight is covered by the amount designated under "Club Championship" in the current years CWGA 18 Budget.

Over-all Winner

- The CWGA 18 Champion gets the CWGA 18 Club Champion Trophy to keep for a year- her name is engraved on it after the tournament. The CWGA 18 Trophy and a bouquet of flowers are awarded to the Champion at reception following play on day two.
- There is a CWGA 18 Club Champion Plaque displayed at the Club - Name plate engraved after tournament
- A "gift" to keep is awarded at the Spring Luncheon (or at the Tournament Reception)

Low Gross winners in each flight

- 1st place winners get a flower and gift to keep awarded at Spring Luncheon. (or at the Tournament Reception)
- Chits are awarded to approximately 1/3 of the field

Caloosa Golf and Country Club Awards Night – The Champion and 1st Low Gross winners in each flight are recognized. Trophies and Plaques should be displayed at the awards dinner and winners should bring their personal "Gifts" to be "re-presented".

President's Cup – Costs for engraving name on Trophy/Plaque and the purchase of flowers and gift for the overall winner is covered specifically in the current year's CWGA 18 Budget under line item Trophies and Gifts.

Prize money (chits) awarded to the winners in each flight is covered specifically by the amount designated under "President's Cup" in the current years CWGA 18 Budget.

Over-all winner

- Gets Flowers presented at Reception following 2nd day of play.
- A gift, usually a large crystal item with engraving (Caloosa logo, year and name of tournament) is awarded by the Caloosa Golf and Country Club President at the Reception or at the December Luncheon. The Handicap Chairlady purchases the gift.
- There is a President's Cup Plaque displayed at the Club –name plate is engraved after the tournament

Flight Winners

- Approximately one-third of the field will receive chits to Pro Shop.

Caloosa Golf and Country Club Awards Night –The over-all Champion is recognized. Plaque should be displayed at the awards dinner and winner should bring her personal "Gift" to be "re-presented".

Member-Member - There are no trophies, plaques or gifts for this Tournament.

- Chits are awarded per tournament guidelines and are covered specifically by the amount designated under "Member Member" in the current years CWGA 18 Budget.
- Caloosa Golf and Country Club Awards Night – The first place teams in each flight can be recognized. (you may want to consider a flower or something to give to those winners who attend)

- **Member Guest** - There are no Trophies, Plaques or Gifts for this Tournament. There is no money in the CWGA 18 Budget for this event. All funding for expenses and prize money comes from the entry fees, mulligans, throws, 50/50 and other fundraisers. Members receive chits and guests receive checks per tournament guidelines

Caloosa Golf and Country Club Awards Night – Winners of this Tournament may be recognized. This is at the discretion of the CWGA 18 Board.

Home and Home - There are no Trophies, Plaques or Gifts for this Tournament. There is no money in the CWGA 18 Budget for this event. All funding for expenses and prize money comes from the entry fees, mulligans, throws, 50/50 and other fundraisers.

- Members receive chits in the Pro Shop and Scepter guests receive checks per tournament guidelines.

Caloosa Golf and Country Awards Night – Winners of this tournament are not recognized.

Triangular - There are no CWGA 18 Trophies, Plaques or Gifts for this Tournament. There is a Triangular Tournament Traveling Trophy which is awarded to the winning Club. There is no money in the CWGA 18 Budget for this event. All funding for expenses and prize money comes from the entry fees.

- When we are hosting, Caloosa Members receive chits in the Pro Shop and Scepter / Renaissance guests receive checks.

Caloosa Golf and Country Club Awards Night – If Caloosa wins the Tournament, the Team Members are recognized and the Trophy is displayed.

Other Awards – The following awards are all presented at the December luncheon each year. Winners of these awards may be recognized at the Club's awards night at the discretion of the CWGA Board. These costs are covered in the current year's CWGA 18 Budget.

- Most Improved Golfer – Specific cash awards from current year's CWGA 18 Budget for first, second and third places. There is a Most Improved Golfer Plaque displayed at the Club –name plate is engraved with the name of the first place winner.
- "I Broke Awards"- Pins are awarded for those breaking down into 100's, 90's, 80's and 70's for the first time during a CWGA 18 event.
- Hole-in one, Eagles, Birdies and Ringers – Specific cash awards - see budgeted amounts
- Outgoing President Gift - Usually an engraved crystal or other engraved item. Outgoing president is usually consulted on any preference she may have.

Misc. The Handicap Chair lady purchases and wraps the "gifts" for presentation. The current year's budget amounts must be adhered to. Rainbow Engravers in Brandon is used for engraving the plates. Things Remembered at the Brandon Mall is where our "gifts" have been purchased. Both of these businesses already have the Caloosa Logo set up in their engraving. The CWGA 18 President is responsible for seeing that the engraving of winner's names on the various plaques is accomplished.
