

CWGA 18 Procedure: A question about the Rules of Golf comes up during play.

USGA and Caloosa Golf and Country Club Local Rules govern tournament play. Whenever possible, a player should play 2 balls if there is a question about a rule. When the round is over, do not sign the scorecard. Present the questioned rule to the tournament chairperson(s). The chairperson will contact the CWGA 18 Rules Chairperson to research/clarify/document the rule. When the determination is made, the ruling will be provided to the tournament chairperson(s). The chairperson(s)/rules person will let the affected player(s) know the ruling. The scorecard is amended if needed and the affected player(s) attest and sign the card. In the event additional time is needed to research a USGA Rule, the CWGA 18 Rules Chairperson will advise the tournament Chair, the affected players and advise them when she has completed her research.
